

* For Communities with manual 3-man Garbage Service call **822-2075** for a copy of your guidelines.



HAZARDOUS WASTE:

Paint, motor oil, pesticides or their containers, batteries, gas tanks, propane tanks, flammable liquids, tires etc..
Call the Solid Waste Authority at **640-4000** for the nearest location to dispose of these items.
Do Not place at the curb for the City to pick up.



Recycling Materials: paper, newspaper, aluminum cans plastics, metals, etc. All cardboard boxes must be flattened to max. 3' X 3' for pick up.
Place bins a minimum of 5' from garbage can.
Place recycle bins at the curb after 6 p.m. the night before normal recycle service and retrieve before the end of the day of collection.
Do Not place recycle bins on top of garbage, bulk items, or vegetation, and do not put garbage in recycle bins.
Call Waste Mgmt. at **866-NEW BINS** to order recycle bins. For your pick up day call **547-4000**

CODE ENFORCEMENT: All violation issues regarding Sanitation should be directed to the Sanitation Code Enforcement Officer listed on the citation.

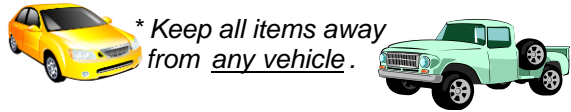

* Keep all items away from any vehicle.

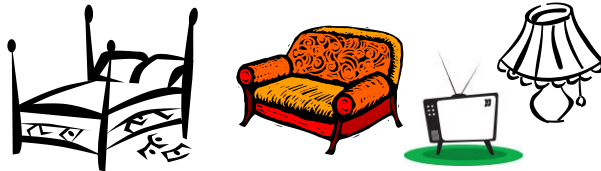
GARBAGE SERVICE: (household waste consists of food matter, food packaging and soiled paper)

Place garbage at curb/edge of street after 6 pm the day **BEFORE** pick-up and retrieve before the end of the day of collection. Garbage set out on the day of pick-up may not be out in time as truck times vary and they may have already been in your area.

Place residential garbage in closed plastic bags before placing into garbage cans.

Do Not place garbage with your vegetation (yard waste) and do not place garbage in cardboard boxes.

* Residential multi-family facilities with a dumpster are to follow community or landlord guidelines. Any bulk items near dumpster require a **Special Pick Up**. (There is a minimum charge for this service.)



BULK ITEMS: Consist of items like sofas, chairs mattresses, box springs, appliances including refrigerators, freezers, drained water heaters, and window air conditioners. Please call Sanitation at **822-2075** if you are unsure about an item.

"REFRIGERATOR DOORS MUST BE REMOVED"

Place bulk items at the curb / edge of street, away from the garbage can or any other obstruction such as a mailbox, tree, low hanging wire, or fence, and place only in front of "your home" after 6 pm the night before pick-up.

When you see **ILLEGAL DUMPING** call **WPB POLICE** at **822-1900**



Carpet is to be rolled in sections no wider than 4 feet and placed out as a bulk item. (no more than 4 or 5 rolls at a time)

Do Not place boxes out for pick-up.

Boxes must be flattened and put with the recycling bins. No flattened box can be larger than **3 feet by 3 feet** as that is the size of the slot in the truck.



Do Not place any kind of construction material, including but not limited to lumber, toilets, sinks, fencing, paneling, drywall, steel, glass, concrete, brick, roofing material, floor tile, plumbing fixtures or cabinetry, out for collection. These items can be removed by your contractor or yourself and taken to the Solid Waste Authority or call **561 822-2075**



SANITATION to schedule a "special pick-up". (There is a minimum charge for this service.)

Do Not place more than 2-4 bulk items out for pick-up at any one time on your regular pick-up day. If you have more items you can either wait til the following week or call for a "special pick-up" **561 822-2075**

(There is a minimum charge for this service.)

YARD WASTE: (i.e. vegetation, tree trimmings, grass clippings, palm fronds, leaves and shrub trimmings.)

* Multi-family dwellings and Commercial facilities are not entitled to yard waste collection.



Place yard waste at the curb / edge of the street after 6 pm the night before pick-up. **ONE PILE ONLY** and **ONLY IN FRONT OF YOUR HOUSE.** You **cannot** place your yard waste in front of your neighbors house even with their permission, this is a violation.

SIZE OF YARD WASTE PILE

Once a week you are allowed one pile, not larger than 4' high, 4' wide, 17' long (apx. length of parking space)



Place grass cuttings, small trimmings and leaves in plastic bags.

Place yard waste in front of your house, **not on the property line**, and **not in front of a vacant lot** even if you own the lot. "Vacant lots are not entitled to pick-up service"

Cut tree limbs and branches into lengths no longer than 4'. **Cut** tree trunks and stumps into sections no longer than 4' and no larger than 12" in diameter. **Homeowner** must clean up debris remaining after pick-up.

Do Not place yard waste within 10' of any obstruction such as a wall, tree, guide wire, fence, vehicle, overhead wire, etc.

Do Not place yard waste in cardboard boxes.

Do Not place yard waste on top of water lines, gas lines or electrical lines.

Do Not mix yard waste with any other items. **2 to 4** bulk items, as defined in guidelines, may be placed **NEXT TO** your yard waste pile.

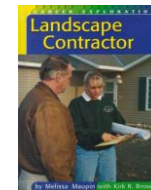
"CEASE ALL CUTTING ONCE A STORM IS NAMED"

Call **SANITATION 822-2075**

for a "**Special Pick-up**" of waste or bulk piles that are larger than the maximum amount allowed.

(There is a minimum charge for this service.)

LANDSCAPE & LAWN SERVICES



Do Not place vegetation left by **Landscapers, Lawn Service, Tree Trimmers, etc..** out for the City to pick up after. Any type of paid Landscape Service is responsible for hauling away any and all debris associated with their work.
